## What to Expect at Trinity

## Children's Ministries

### Sunday School

Sundays, 9:30 a.m.

### Children's Church

Sundays, 11:15 am

Children four years through fifth grade join their parents in worship during the first 20 minutes of the Sunday Morning service and then leave for a time of dynamic Bible lessons, Bible memory, activities, and Kid's Choir.

### Children's Choir

Sundays am, Kids' Choir

Teaching Biblical principles through singing, musical activities and movement. Little Kids' Choir is for children 4 years - 1st grade. Big Kids' Choir is for 2nd - 5th graders.

A program of activities, Bible stories and Bible memorization for children three years through fifth grade. Runs September through April.

## Student Ministries

### The Summit

Sundays, 5:45 - 7:15 PM (Sept-April)

9th - 12th Grades

The Summit is a time for senior high students to gather together in joyful pursuit of our living God. The first half of the night is filled with worship through games, food, and music. From there we break into small groups as we open God's Word, encourage each other to live in joyful obedience, and uphold each other in prayer.

### Base Camp

Wednesdays, 6:45 - 8:15 PM (Sept-April)

6th - 8th Grades

Base Camp is a time for junior high students to learn the foundations of joyfully pursuing our living God. It is a night filled with games, food, and singing. The second half of the night is spent in small groups as we look at the foundational truths of God's Word and think through how those truths can shape our eternal destiny and our daily living.

### Sunday School

Sundays, 9:30 - 10:30 AM

Our Sunday School hour is about going deeper in God's Word to really get to know who He is and who we are called to be.

The Junior High class (6th - 8th grades) walks chronologically through the Bible so students can see the big picture of God's redemptive work.

The Senior High class (9th - 12th grades) zooms in on different topics and parts of scripture - theology, apologetics, the names of God, minor prophets, the epistles, etc - to get a clearer picture of the God we serve.
